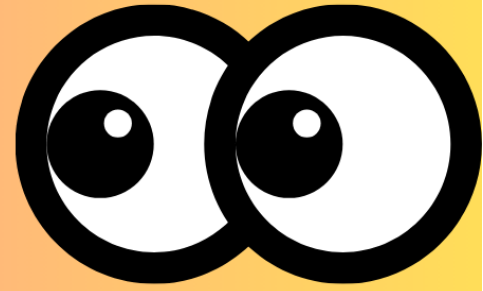

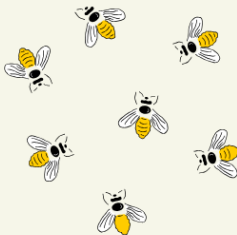
Our objective in this week's classes is to learn about bees.

CHAPLAIN'S CORNER

What Is So Important About Family Prayer? Focus on the Family

Prayer for family is foundational to spiritual growth. Prayer is a very personal form of communication between us and God, our Creator. Prayer is an essential skill, and your kids will learn it from you as you do it together. Nothing will communicate the *why* and the *how* of effective prayer to your kids like seeing you pray.

Prayer Strengthens Relationships

Prayer means time with God, speaking to Him, and — just as necessary — listening to Him. The more time you spend with God, the more your relationship with Him will grow.

By praying with your family, you are building relationships with them as well. Whatever the case may be, you are spending time with them, having shared experiences, and supporting them.

Prayer Fosters Communication and Spiritual Awareness

Here are some of the things you may see as a result of consistent, effective prayer with and for your family:

- Improved trust and openness to share struggles, fears, and more.
- Family spiritual growth and opportunities for your kids to connect with their faith.

A greater chance that your kids will approach situations from a spiritual perspective.

Tips for Praying With Your Family

What could prayer look like in your family? The first step is to establish a culture of effective prayer in your household. You may already be doing this, but if not, don't worry — you can start today. In Ephesians, it says to “pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests” (Ephesians 6:18a). Make your house a place filled with all kinds of prayers!

Pray Right Away

The idea is simple: when a family member asks for you to pray for them, don't just say you'll pray for them and then walk away. Pray for them, right then and there. Make a point to do this whenever possible. You can impact them at that moment by taking the time to pray with them and show them that they are important to you.

Pray to Show Love

Praying with them at the moment can also help fulfill your family member's love language — whether that's physical touch, words of affirmation, or something else. If your child approaches you with something to pray about, put your arm around them and begin to pray, modeling the love that God has for us. Highlight this love by thanking God that He wants us to bring our cares and anxieties to Him (1 Peter 5:6-7).

Pray Using Their Words and Input

Be sure to use the words your child used when asking for prayer, so they know you are actively listening to them (“Dear God, I pray that you would help Bobby forgive Jason for the mean things that he said...”). Then, ask your child if there is anything they would like to add in prayer. After that, wrap up. It's quick but powerful!

Praying for strength, understanding and discernment as you lead your children in the way of Christ!

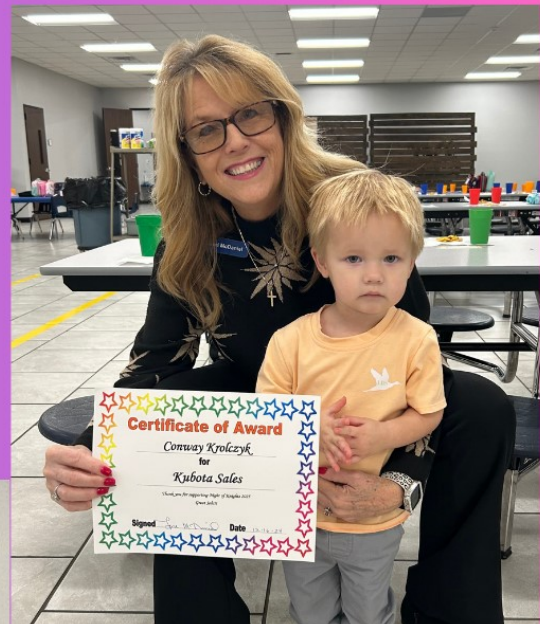

We have heard your questions, and here is a basic overview of Night of Knights and our Missions Project. Please watch for information in the FYI, emails, and parent alerts.

What is Night of Knights (NOK)?

- NOK is Faith Academy's biggest fundraiser and happens only once a year.
- It's always on the 2nd Saturday in February. This year is Saturday, February 8, 2025 @ 5pm.
- NOK is at the Expo Center, Austin County Fairgrounds.
- The money raised at NOK goes into keeping our tuition low and the lights on!
- It is semi-formal, with dinner, a program, fun themes, raffles, drawings, live, silent, and dessert auctions. This year there is a Missions Outfit Contest.
- This year's theme is **Missions Possible**, please see below for more details on the Missions NOK Project.

What is our Missions Project at Night of Knights?

- Upper and lower classes will partner together with a chosen Mission Country.
- We are representing six countries – South Africa, Honduras, Kenya, Poland, Costa Rica, and Central Asia, EEC is representing local missions.
- Each country will have a pop-up tent at NOK to represent the country. The tent will showcase class projects and much more.
- All FA Teachers and Students will work together with volunteers to learn about their mission country, find ways to bless a cross-cultural worker in their country, and make artifacts (art, food, crafts), and display facts about the country in creative ways.
- Each team will also produce an "infomercial" for their country and cross-cultural workers to be viewed during NOK.
- The goal is to raise awareness of God's movements around the globe and raise funds to bless these cross-cultural workers.
- We have a GroupMe & a DOC set up for each country.


