7th Grade Texas History Field Trip

Faith Academy's seventh graders explored Texas history with a visit to the Alamo, Bandera and Monument Hill. Thanks to James Crawford, a longtime junior high history teacher at Faith Academy, the students were well prepared and able to fully engage with the exhibits at the Alamo. Their favorite exhibits and artifacts were housed in the Alamo Collection building. A large model of the Alamo at the time of the battle, which included an audio and visual presentation by Phil Collins, helped the students to put all of their facts together and finally imagine what it would be like for the brave men, women and children that were present during this historic battle for Texas independence. In Bandera students explored the Texas hill country, played and worshipped together. At Monument Hill in La Grange students were impressed by the fact that so many men from this one area left their families to go fight for Texas independence and did not survive. Students were grateful for the beautiful weather on their trip as well as having time away from the classroom and exploring historical sites in person.

Classroom Observation

CLASSROOM OBSERVATION DAYS FOR PARENTS SPRING SEMESTER 2025

Things you should know:

- There are **10** observation days in the spring semester
 - **May 9** is the last day to observe
- The following days are not available for observations:

Fri-Mon, April 18 & 21 (Good Friday & Easter Monday)

Mon-Fri, April 28-May 2 (IOWA Testing for JH & Elementary)

Mon-Fri, April 28-May 2 - Observation in EEC & HS is ok

Iowa Assessments Testing

The Iowa Test is an achievement test used to assess student learning in reading, language, math, science, and social studies.

Kindergarten through 8th grade students will test Tuesday through Thursday, **April 29, 30, and May 1**, from approx. **8:00 to 11:00 AM**.

Friday, May 2, will be used as a make-up test day.

Please refrain from making any morning appointment for your child on these days.

Classroom observations on testing days for students K-8th should only be planned after lunch.

A small snack will be provided each day. Students should bring a water bottle daily.

Lunch will be served as usual.

Test Taking Tips for Students (& Parents)

Get a good night's sleep. Being rested helps you think more clearly.

Eat a healthy breakfast to sustain your energy. Avoid sugary goods that can give you're a rush of energy but will wear off quickly, leaving you feeling tired.

Drink plenty of water. If possible, bring a bottle of water with your on test days.

Listen carefully to your teacher's directions.

Pray for guidance.

Give thanks to God for your abilities.

Remember that God has a purpose and is with your always providing never-ending love and grace.

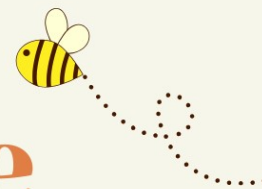

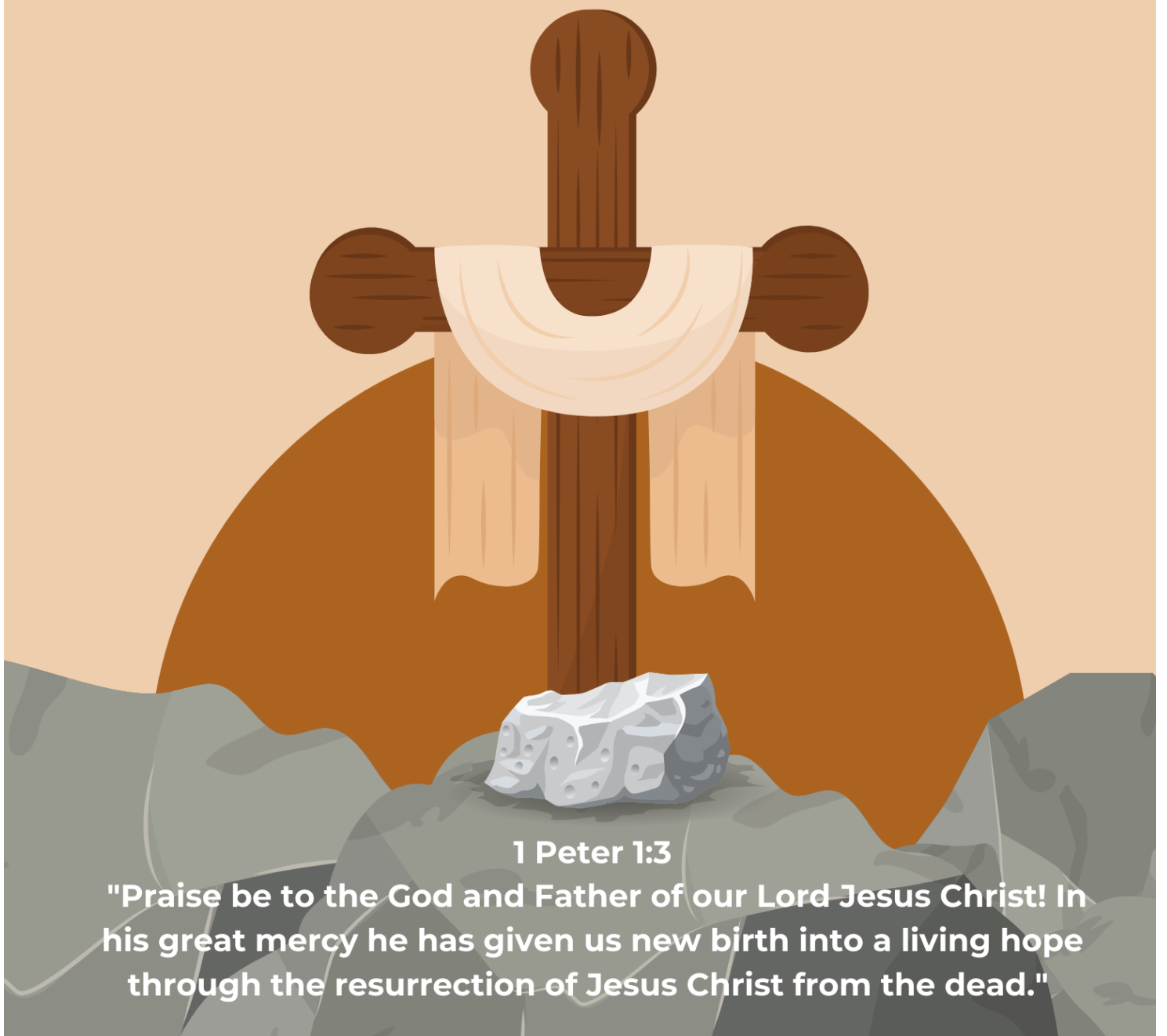
