The Knightly News

One of the most coveted Silent Auction items at the annual Night of Knights fundraiser gala is the Elementary Principal for the Day. As students, who among us wouldn't have loved to take over the school and make the rules?

This year, the bidding got competitive, and two students walked away with the prize. They each had the opportunity to be Mrs. Jennifer McCutcheon, the Faith Academy Bellville Elementary Director, for the day.

Instead of enforcing the rules, both Miss Ila Hargrave, 5th grade, and Miss Stella Burson, 4th grade, spent the day encouraging students and teachers alike and providing plenty of opportunities for fun.

A Vision for the Day

Before their day as principal, Mrs. McCutcheon sat with each student to talk about their vision for the day. They each received a "Teacher Cup," a clipboard with "You Were Caught Being Good Certificates," and a notepad and pen. The notepad and pen were a must because, as Mrs. McCutcheon said, "In this job, you can't think you're going to remember everything people say to you during the day; you have to write it down."

Mrs. McCutcheon said their plans were motivated by one question: "How am I going to make school better for my friends?"

More Fun, More Fresh Air

Both Principals for the Day granted the students the most requested gift of all - extra recess. In fact, when asked what the one change they would make to the school day would be, they both said permanent extra recess. Principal Hargrave explained that she plays soccer during recess, so she is moving her body and exercising, which is important for the students' brains and learning.

"Extra recess was huge for both of them, and that tells us something. We should probably be outside more, and give kids more time to think and talk together," Mrs. McCutcheon said.

Dance parties were welcome interruptions throughout the day. The principals both enjoyed declaring a dance party over the school intercom.

Using Their Power for Good

One of the greatest things about the day, according to Mrs. McCutcheon, was the clipboard activity. Each principal could hand out certificates and prizes to fellow students who were "caught doing something good." Mrs. McCutcheon pointed out that the girls didn't just hand out the certificates but wrote in detail what each one was for. Their prize bags had to be refilled multiple times because "that's just how much love they were showing others," Mrs. McCutcheon said.

Principal Burson wanted to expand it to the teachers and used a “Kudos” pad to celebrate teachers and staff for their good work, too. Mrs. McCutcheon said she will always cherish her “Kudos” sheet from Principal Burson, which said, “You’re just an awesome teacher!”

Each grade level also has a Knight’s Shield on the wall to encourage positive behavior. Both principals moved each class’ shields along the board, and as a result, many classes earned a free dress day to wear clothes of their choice instead of their daily Faith Academy uniform.

Both declared holidays of sorts to keep the fun going after their day in charge. Principal Hargrave made the following Tuesday “Crazy Sock Day,” allowing students to show off their personalities with socks. In the next few weeks, as the weather warms up, students will enjoy a cold, sweet treat at a Popsicle Party planned especially for them by Principal Burson.

They also took over some of the regular aspects of the day, like leading devotional with the 5th graders and Character education with the 3rd grade.

What Leadership Looks Like

At the end of the day, both principals said that the central aspect of the job is “to make sure that nobody is being hurt and everybody is being treated right.”

What started as a silent-auction item idea years ago has become an opportunity for students to live out a dream while supporting their friends and gaining leadership experience.

Mrs. McCutcheon knows something about childhood dreams. As a young student, she wrote that she wanted to teach and write a book, and she's accomplished both. She says that tells her that even when we're young, our experiences are quietly shaping who we'll become.

For Ila and Stella, one day as principal was more than a prize; it was a chance to lead with kindness, lift up their classmates, and discover what it really means to be in charge. And if the student body has anything to say about it, they’d welcome them back anytime.
