Others have busy work schedules and prefer to help with after-hours events, such as high school dances, the annual garage sale, or even support that can be done from home.

THE FUNMAKERS

Room parents, also known as the “funmakers,” are led by Whitney Dorton, a FAB parent and longtime dedicated volunteer. In addition to coordinating food and fun for the classroom holiday parties, room parents also keep families informed about important grade-specific information, help organize the Night of Knights classroom projects, support teacher appreciation events throughout the year, and more.

EVERY AGE EVERY WAY TO SERVE

When students are younger, in early childhood and elementary school, volunteering might come more naturally, but it tends to drop off in junior high and high school. As parents take a step back and let their older children handle schedules and responsibilities more independently, it's hard to know where to participate on campus. In the past, volunteer teams have consisted of a parent or parents from each high school grade, creating a natural succession plan and camaraderie among the group.

Events Assistant Krista Goebel said last year a committee of parents filled a specific need in high school: bulletin board decorating. In the lower grades, teachers generally design their own bulletin boards, but in junior high and high
