

Athletics News from the Courts, Trails, and Fields

The Knights had a full and exciting week of athletics!

Volleyball

The Lady Knights went 0–2 on the week, falling to Aggieland Homeschool (1–3) and Aristoi (1–3). While they didn't notch a win, the team continues to grow while competing against two strong opponents. They'll be back in action this Friday as they travel to Brazos, with JV beginning at 5:00 p.m., followed by Varsity.

Football

The Knights wrapped up their preseason with their final scrimmage before kicking off the regular season in the Texas 6-Man Kickoff at Allen Academy. The scrimmage featured four teams—San Antonio Lutheran North, Our Lady of the Hills, Compass Rose Academy, and the Knights. Faith Academy dominated the day, outscoring its three opponents 12 touchdowns to four. The Knights officially open their season this Saturday at 7:30 p.m. against Baytown Christian.

Cross Country

The Knights Cross Country team had a big showing at the St. John XXIII meet in Katy. Senior Ethan Stegant finished 19th out of 90 in the Varsity Boys division, while sophomore Quinton Moore placed 70th out of 94 in the JV Boys race. In the Junior High Girls division, 6th grader Shelby Poulter placed 7th out of 76, and 7th grader Eva Broadbent earned an impressive 3rd-place finish. Coach Howie and her team will travel to Schulenburg this Thursday for their next meet.

Our spirited Junior High Cheerleaders are supported by the adorable Knight Lights Pep Squad, a group of joyful kindergarten through 5th-grade girls who cheer through the first half of football games, perform at pep rallies, and attend other school events. Their school spirit and pride are contagious!

Please familiarize yourself with School Health Policies

Student Medication

- Students may not self carry any medication.
- Medication will only be administered after written instructions are provided or direct communication with Nurse
- Please utilize Magnus or FAB Medication Authorization Forms

Fever Policy

- Students with a temperature of 100 degrees or above will require them to be sent home.
- May return to school when fever free (less than 100 degrees) for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication.
- If a child has a fever at home prior to the start of school, we ask that they remain at home and follow the 24 hour policy.

Vomiting/Diarrhea Policy

 In an effort to keep every child protected, any child who vomits or has diarrhea will be sent home and should remain home until they have not vomited or had diarrhea for a full 24 hours without the aid of medications.

 If a child vomits or has diarrhea prior to the start of school, we ask that they remain at home and follow the 24 hour policy.

What a wonderful week of new beginnings! Faith Academy Bellville welcomed 339 Knights to campus - including 82 new students - on Wednesday, August 13. From the smallest students in our Early Education Center (EEC) stepping onto campus for the first time to the high school seniors beginning their year with Senior Sunrise, it was a joy to see everyone.

Not only are students' schedules full of learning, but the student clubs, activities, and sports are also back in full swing.

Clubs and Activities

As the Austin County Fair approaches, Faith Academy FFA and Junior FFA are working hard on their fair projects. They're also hosting fundraisers to support the group's activities with sales of poinsettias, meats, and gifts.

Several years ago, Faith Academy partnered with a national chess program—fittingly named *The Knight School*—to give our kindergarten through 7th grade students the opportunity to learn, play, and enjoy the game of chess. This year's chess club will launch on August 21, and we can't wait to get the boards set up and the pieces moving.

Athletics

Faith Academy is off to a strong start this athletic season!

Volleyball opens the year 3–3, opening with a tough loss to Allen Academy before bouncing back to go 3–2 at the Faith Academy Tournament.

Football had its first scrimmage of the year at Allen Academy in a four-way matchup against Allen Academy, Veritas Academy, Kingwood Covenant, and St. Joseph Catholic School. The Knights outscored every opponent on the night and entered the season ranked #6 in the TAPPS Division 3 Six-Man preseason poll.

Cross Country opened its season at the Frio Nights meet in Sealy, with three runners finishing in the top half of their divisions against strong competition.

Behind the scenes, the Knights Athletic Booster Club makes it possible for our athletes to compete in the sports they love, providing the uniforms, equipment, and support they need. Throughout the year, members raise funds and volunteer their time, and this year's meetings kick off on August 25.


Staff Safety Training
