Meet Mrs. Kelli Diers, Faith Academy Bellville's New Head of School

Faith Academy Bellville (FAB) enthusiastically welcomes Mrs. Kelli Diers as our new Head of School! With 25 years serving in Christian education - from Houston's premier St. Anne Catholic School to our neighbor in Brenham, Citadel Christian School, and other well-known Christian schools - Mrs. Diers has supported students and staff in a variety of leadership roles. She brings not only valuable academic and leadership experience to FAB but also a commitment to relationships as she lives out the motto "every student, every teacher, every day."

While Mrs. Diers is new to FAB, the school has been on her radar for a decade. She noticed FAB as she traveled to Round Top, visiting a restored 1800s family property she calls "the hard work resort." When she saw the Head of School job opening, she didn't apply right away but took time to pray. In January, God gave her that little tug at her heart, and she began the months-long application and interview process. Every step of the way, she got to know the staff and community better and walked away thinking, "I really love this place."

The FAB sense of community, our leadership's commitment to a strong biblical foundation while always looking ahead to what's next, and the opportunity to finally move to the country all influenced Mrs. Diers' decision to join the FAB family.

"I love that part of our mission is to be a place where 'the Light of the World, Jesus Christ' lives in each person," Mrs. Diers said. "The question is, what does that look like in our daily lives? I'm excited to continue exploring that and discovering new ways we can let His light shine through our Faith Academy community."

While she's getting her bearings, Mrs. Diers says the top priority is establishing relationships and understanding what's already working well to support those endeavors.

"We all have the same common goals: a successful school, students who graduate as great, contributing members of society, and who come back to serve the school they graduated from," Mrs. Diers said. "We might have different ways to get there, but if we don't have those relationships intact, it's hard to come to the table and work it out together."

A CALLING TO CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

Mrs. Diers initially earned her degree in psychology from Texas A&M (Whoop!) and intended to become a clinical psychologist, but God had other plans. She went on to earn a Master of Education with a concentration in Counseling from the University of Houston. Twenty-five years ago this August, she began her journey in Christian education. "I can't think of my life not working in Christian education. Once I hit that path, I can't think of anything else," she shared.

As she began her career in 2001 as a part-time counselor at St. Anne's, Mrs. Diers recalls, "They'd never had a counselor before, and I'd never been one, so what could go wrong? We'd figure it out together." After that first year, she went full-time and established the school's first counseling department, supporting students, families and staff for 13 years.

At that point, and with a subtle push from St. Anne's principal, Mrs. Diers moved into the administrative role of Dean of Students.

"I always remember my very first day as Dean of Students, thinking, 'Wow, this is a huge responsibility,' she said. "I never want to lose that feeling, because if we do, we lose our humility. I'm honored to have this responsibility, and I want to make sure I keep that focus."

One of the goals of Christian education is to create a culture where every student has a genuine sense of belonging. Mrs. Diers helped bring that to life through fostering "Families" at St. Anne and implementing the House System at two additional schools. Through these programs, students of all ages were grouped together for year-long mentoring, events, friendly competitions, and service projects. Mrs. Diers witnessed firsthand how the programs helped students build connections, creating smoother transitions from elementary to junior high and from junior high into high school.

"You want to give students a reason to stay and something to look forward to. Building programs like the House System is one way to help students feel connected to their school and community," she said.

After offering the positive discipline framework "Love & Logic" to parents, Mrs. Diers implemented the program and trained teachers and staff at St. Anne's and at each of the schools she subsequently served at.

"I love using Love & Logic techniques within a school because our students will be faced with decisions that are eternal in nature by the time they graduate here. This gives them the opportunity while they're younger in safe places to make decisions and sometimes mistakes socially and academically that aren't life-changing," Mrs. Diers explained.

A CAREER BUILT ACROSS CAMPUSES

After St. Anne's, Mrs. Diers moved to First Baptist Academy in Houston, starting as Director of Student Life for the whole campus before being promoted to Principal, first over Middle School and then over grades 3–8. She then joined Northland Christian School in Houston, rising from Assistant Principal of the Secondary campus to Principal of Secondary, and finally Principal over the entire PreK–12 campus.

Most recently, she served as PreK–12 Principal at Citadel Christian School in Brenham, where she fell in love with working outside of the hustle and bustle of Houston. She is grateful to continue a strong relationship with Citadel Christian School, as both schools serve our neighboring counties.

Several other programs Mrs. Diers championed at various campuses include the Distinguished Diploma program and the AP Capstone Diploma, both of which require completion of rigorous coursework and achievement of specific goals. During Mrs. Diers' tenure, Northland Christian School earned Gold Honor Roll Status from the College Board for two consecutive years, a distinction awarded to schools where a strong share of graduates take, and succeed in, Advanced Placement coursework, reflecting a school-wide culture of college readiness. At multiple schools, Mrs. Diers has facilitated services for students with diverse learning needs, including contributing to the establishment of learning centers.

Mrs. Diers also has a passion for athletics and served as cheer coach for 14 years, coached a softball team, and also served as Assistant Athletic Director.

FAMILY, FAITH, AND ADVENTURE

Outside of school, Mrs. Diers is married with two adult children and two grandchildren. She loves to travel with her family and has been to amazing destinations such as Italy for her 25th wedding anniversary, the San Juan Islands, and Kauai, to name a few. Ask her about skiing in the Swiss Alps!

“There was a moment when no one else was around, and I thought, I am standing on the Alps; look at this beauty the Lord has created. I started crying,” Mrs. Diers shared.

Cooking, musicals, and college football also top the list of her interests and hobbies. Mrs. Diers is a student herself and is completing her Doctor of Education degree in Educational Leadership at Liberty University.

As we begin the 2026-27 school year, we offer gratitude for Mrs. Diers and pray for all of our FAB students, teachers, staff, and families that this is a successful school year.

Mrs. Diers shared her vision for FAB’s role in our students’ lives.

“The ultimate privilege is that we get to walk alongside students as they find their place in God's unfolding story for them. That's what we're here to do.”

School Health Policies

Please communicate any active health concerns for your child with the School Nurse, e.g., rashes, injuries outside of school, return to school doctor's notes, etc.

Student Medication

- Students may not self carry any medication.
- Medication will only be administered by the School Nurse with a completed Medication Authorization Form or direct communication with Nurse

Fever Policy

- Students with a temperature of 100 degrees or above will require them to be sent home.
- May return to school when fever free (less than 100 degrees) for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication.
- If a child has a fever at home prior to the start of school, we ask that they remain at home and follow the 24 hour policy.

Vomiting/Diarrhea Policy

- In an effort to keep every child protected, any child who vomits or has diarrhea will be sent home and should remain home until they have not vomited or had diarrhea for a full 24 hours without the aid of medications.
- If a child vomits or has diarrhea prior to the start of school, we ask that they remain at home and follow the 24 hour policy.
