

Faith Academy Students Give Back to the Community

Faith Academy Bellville (FAB) draws strength from our community's love and support, which inspires us to serve others locally and around the world. As we celebrate Christ's birth this Christmas, FAB students are putting faith into action, joyfully serving others in our community and beyond.

Sharing Christmas Joy with Local Senior Living Residents

Our Elementary Survive and Thrive classes, taught by Ms. Sheri Watson, have been writing Christmas letters to each resident at Colonial Living and Rehabilitation of Bellville and to other homebound community members. The students, in grades kindergarten through 5th grade, each draw a person's name and write a letter to them. Our 129 elementary students write letters to the 48 Colonial Living residents, ensuring each person receives at least two beautiful, thoughtful cards.

Ms. Watson creates form letters for the younger kids to write. For the kindergarteners, the letter begins with "Merry Christmas" and includes blanks to fill in, leaving all the decorating to the little letter writers. First graders also receive a letter with blanks to fill in, such as "I'm praying for you…" Second graders are given more room to write from their hearts to their recipient. 4th- and 5th-graders write letters from the heart, allowing them to share the Love of Christ while also practicing the format of a well-written letter.

Last year, the letters were heartfelt and loving, truly reflecting each student's love for their community and for Jesus. One student shared in her letter, "I know you're lonesome, but know that this fourth grader cares about you and is praying for you."

The Survive and Thrive classes also write letters to local veterans whom Ms. Watson is connected to through the regional, veteran-owned high-speed internet provider, Wifinity Networks.

Not only are the words shared part of the gift, but students also decorate each letter and envelope with prayer and other decorative Christmas stickers, along with the children's drawings, transforming each letter into a Christmas decoration.

As acts of kindness often do, these letters have a profound impact on both the giver and the recipient.

Looking Ahead to Support More Community Members

Ms. Watson has plans for future community outreach, including treating local law enforcement to muffins or cookies made from pancake mix by the Survive and Thrive students. Because Ms. Watson is passionate about making good use of all donations given to her class, she also plans to use donated materials to make dog beds in class for the local animal shelter.

Spreading Love Across the World with Operation Christmas Child

For more than 10 years, Faith Academy has been sharing gifts with children around the world through Operation Christmas Child. Sponsored by our National Junior Honor Society members, students can fill a shoe-sized box with small toys, clothes, socks, and other items. As students select items and pack their boxes, they pray for the children who will receive them, helping our students learn that kindness takes action, not just good intentions.

This year, FAB students filled and mailed 96 boxes to children they will never know or meet, yet they have connected with them in a very impactful and loving way.

NJHS sponsor Mrs. Stacy Woodley noted that it's essential to give our students the opportunity to recognize that Christmas and life aren't only about what they get, but also about sharing blessings with others.

"We often grow up with so much that it's easy to take it for granted, but when children see a single box filled with items like toothbrushes, washcloths, socks, and a few toys, and realize this may be the only gift some children around the world will receive, they begin to understand true gratitude," Mrs. Woodley shared.

The FFA Gathers Food, Shares Love Locally


Each fall for the past four years, Mrs. Cierra Hines-Hacker, Faith Academy Agriculture Science Teacher and FFA Sponsor, has coordinated an annual Thanksgiving Food Drive and Christmas Letter Program.

While the FFA takes charge of the food drive, the entire school gets in on the action with each grade competing to bring the most food. This year, FAB donated seven boxes of non-perishable food to Katy Christian Ministries Food Pantry.

After Thanksgiving, FFA switches into Christmas giving mode, decorating and writing Christmas cards for Industry's Oak Haven Assisted Living and other senior living communities in the area.

Mrs. Hines-Hacker said, "The FAB FFA chapter enjoys giving back to the community. If you ask the students, they will tell you they love it because it helps them to strengthen their social bonds, creating a positive ripple effect, and provides a personal benefit to them, like a sense of purpose."

This Christmas season, we are thankful for our community that loves us so well. We are also grateful for the generosity of our students, families, and staff who seek to meet the needs of others both near and far. We wish our community a wonderful Christmas full of love and wonder.

Flu Season is Here



Dear Parents,

Cold and flu season is upon us. Faith Academy kindly asks that you keep your student home if he or she is not feeling well or is exhibiting any flu-like symptoms including, but not limited to fever (temp 100+), cough, sore throat, body aches, headache, chills, fatigue, vomiting, and diarrhea.

Your cooperation helps ensure the health and safety of all our students and staff.



Tips for Students to Stay Well



Frequent Hand Washing



Stay home when you are sick



Fortify your immune system- fluids, rest, healthy diet, exercise



Avoid sharing personal items to prevent the spread of infection. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.

Faith Academy Illness Policy

4.02-8 - FEVER

Students with a temperature of 100 degrees or above will not be allowed to remain in class. A child may return to class when he or she has been without a fever for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.

4.02-19 - VOMITING AND DIARRHEA

Any child who vomits or has diarrhea will be sent home and should remain home until they have not vomited or had diarrhea for a full 24 hours without the aid of medications. If a child vomits or has diarrhea prior to the start of school, we ask that they remain at home and follow the 24 hour policy.


