100 Years Old... For a Day!

If you visited Faith Academy Bellville (FAB) on January 30, 2026, you might have thought a senior living center party took over campus, as our students dressed up in their best velour jogging suits, pearls, and bifocals to transform into 100-year-olds for the day in celebration of the 100th day of school.

The FAB Elementary students spent the day celebrating, reflecting on all they have learned, and how their character has developed throughout this chapter. Some made necklaces with 100 Cheerios; others researched and presented information about people who lived 100 years or more ago. Every 100 minutes, all elementary students stopped what they were doing for a 100-second dance party! It was a day full of fun and celebration.

As Mrs. Jennifer McCutcheon, Elementary Director, said, "I like taking moments like the 100th day of school and holding them up as something to celebrate. Does it get in the way of learning? No, it's part of it. Learning how to celebrate is essential to life."

While academic achievements and growth are central to a milestone celebration, Mrs. McCutcheon is taking the time to focus on the character development the students have been working toward.

Kindness as a Superpower

At the beginning of the year, elementary students began a character-education program that Mrs. McCutcheon carefully selected to reflect our Christian beliefs. Each week, she meets with students as they focus on virtues and decision-making.

"We started with kindness, because we need that most of all. God tells us, 'Above all, love one another,'" Mrs. McCutcheon explained.

The students started with the basics, learning what it means to be kind. They focused on the importance of choosing kindness over other activities or ignoring others' needs, especially as the newness of the school year wears off and we're tired.

Another lesson in kindness focused on being kind to people in authority, including identifying who is in authority and what it means for someone to be in authority over us. Mrs. McCutcheon explained the righteousness of God and how He gives us authority as well. With that authority, we have to remember to stay within the parameters of right and wrong.

"We can't just take our authority and say everybody needs to pick up all the rocks on the playground for me so I can build a castle. We have to use our authority wisely," she explained.

Big Lessons from a Tiny Dot

A dot on a notecard helped students understand the impact of responsibility. Mrs. McCutcheon gave every student a notecard and asked everyone to draw a dot in the middle. As they performed responsible acts, they would make their dot bigger. If they were not responsible, their dot could shrink. Mrs. McCutcheon said this was a tangible lesson that encouraged students to stop and think, "Did my action help my spot grow or would that make my spot shrink?"

The very first act of responsibility was to hold onto the card. Some students lost their cards and had to kindly ask someone in authority for help tying together the previous lessons.

Perseverance: Trying Again, Together

As Christmas break approached, students were getting weary, making it a great time to discuss perseverance. They sought out stories of people who persevered, even as they faced extremely difficult challenges that would have made it easy to give up. Mrs. McCutcheon said students began to recognize the many blessings in their lives: love, a home, food, heat, school, and family. Still, some challenges require perseverance to see them through, and students can share them on sticky notes attached to a bulletin board in the cafeteria for all to see. Each morning, Mrs. McCutcheon selects one, and that student gets a prize.

Several weeks ago, students were teamed up and given a box of materials, such as cups, straws, paper, and cardboard. Mrs. McCutcheon instructed them to work in a group to build a three-story tower, and each floor had to hold people represented as Lego-type cubes.

Part of the lesson was following directions; when some groups built a five-story tower, they had to start over. Other groups struggled to build a structure, and they learned that it's ok to fail because you can persevere. Each grade handled the lesson uniquely, Mrs. McCutcheon said.

"Each grade approached perseverance differently, but they did it, and it was fun. There was laughter, and there was joy. There were a couple of tears, but we got over it. We moved on, and we persevered," she said.

A Teacher's Journey of Saying "Okay, God"

Most recently, Mrs. McCutcheon shared her own story of perseverance, illustrated with a few of her favorite books: *Hatchet*, *The Good Dog*, *My Side of the Mountain*, and more. Each book centers on grit and endurance, much like her own path.

She graduated from college with a degree in Radio, Television, and Film, a degree she often jokes she's never truly used. Her first job was producing commercials, including spots for World Wrestling Entertainment (WWE), but she didn't enjoy the work. In a moment of prayer, she told God she was struggling, and she felt Him say, "Don't worry. Things are going to happen."

They did. The very next day, she received a call from Jim Goode, one of the kings of Texas BBQ and founder of the Goode Company Restaurant Group. He had an idea he wanted her help with, and even though she doubted her experience, she ended up helping him open the Hall of Flame store on Kirby Drive in Houston. While installing a massive sombrero art piece by Bob Wade, she met the man who would become her husband.

Their life together took them to New Mexico, where she worked as a cowgirl and ranch hand (still no need for the Radio-Television-Film degree), then to a newspaper job at the *Las Vegas Optic* in Las Vegas, New Mexico. They started an outfitting business, welcomed children, and enjoyed the simple joys of country living, like goat milking, which made her happy. When her father was diagnosed with cancer, they moved back to Texas, where her husband worked in the oil and gas industry, and she raised their boys. During that time, she fell in love with gardening, and her potatoes became such a success that they supplied Houston restaurants and were sold at farmers' markets.

When the family decided to homeschool, she worried she wasn't equipped for it. That concern led her to earn her teaching certificate, which revealed her passion for working with students who learn differently. Not long after, she took a job teaching first grade at Faith Academy Bellville in 2010. She taught first grade, then second grade, and her boys attended FAB as well. In 2013, the family made another big move: to Alaska.

In Craig, Alaska, on Prince of Wales Island, she served as a special education teacher. The family had a great adventure there. Her son, Aaron, loved it, while Wyatt missed football, especially Coach James Crawford, and the Bible teachers, Kevin McGonagill and Amy Catlett, at FAB.

Looking back, she says her life had been good up to that point. She talked to God constantly, and He always answered.

"I just kept persevering and always saying 'okay' to God. The more that I said 'okay' to God, the better things got. I mean, honestly," she tells the students.

Eventually, the family moved again. This time to Montana. But when her husband was diagnosed with kidney disease, they returned to Texas. It was a frightening season filled with uncertainty, but she stayed obedient and persevered through the transition. That difficult move brought her back to Faith Academy.

"In my story of perseverance, I told the kids I love what I do here, and I don't feel like this is my job," she said. "I know that God has put me here for a reason. So every time I've said 'okay' to God, it ends up being amazing."

Our students have already learned many valuable lifelong lessons in these first 100 days of the school year, and we celebrate alongside them. We at FAB are blessed that God led Mrs. McCutcheon back to teach and guide our students so they can develop into the people God intended them to be, strengthening their character, gifts, and walk with Him.

FAB ART FESTIVAL

Categories

CALLIGRAPHY: abstract patterns/designs, architectural/commercial designs, hand lettering

DIGITAL ART: artwork produced entirely in electronic form - original creation or digitally enhanced student-generated work, graphic design (text with images), 3-D printing

DRAWING - BLACK & WHITE: media - chalk, charcoal, ink, pencil, pigma/technical pen, scratchboard

DRAWING - COLOR: media - colored pencil, colored ink, crayon, felt markers, pastels (students may enter pastels in the painting category at their discretion)

FABRIC ART: cloth mosaic/collage, embroidery, fabric painting, quilting

FIBER ART: knitting, crochet, weaving, felting, braiding, macrame, lace making, rug/latch hook, stitchery, string art. fiber sculpture

MISCELLANEOUS ART: basketry, jewelry, leather, metal, recycled art, found art, wood, alternative photographic processes (cyanotype, etc.)

MIXED MEDIA: a combination of two or more categories, or artwork can be entered in its dominant category

PAINTING: media - acrylics, airbrush, encaustics, finger paints, oil, tempera, watercolor

PAPER ART: cast paper, diorama, origami, paper mosaic/collage, paper projects, altered art, art journaling

PHOTOGRAPHY - FILM: Images created with a film camera and printed on silver gelatin paper, color or black and white. It may be commercially processed or student processed.

PHOTOGRAPHY - DIGITAL: black and white or color (Photographs that include any person(s) must be accompanied by a completed photo release form for each person in the photograph.)

POTTERY: (functional pieces from fired clay) wheel-thrown or handmade

PRINTMAKING: relief, intaglio, rubbings, silk screen, sponge, stamping, stenciling

RELIEF SCULPTURE (*including subtractive process*): works presented in a relief extending over 1/4 inch above the surface or base

SCULPTURE - 3 DIMENSIONAL, SHAPED BY THE STUDENT: media - ceramic with handmade mold, clay, metal, paper mache, plaster, soap, stone, wood

LEGO ART: media - authentic Lego pieces that cannot be a kit, or already designed scene by Lego. No part of the design resembles any existing LEGO set or official scene. The style is expressive, imaginative, and sculptural—an artwork born entirely from the artist's creative vision.

FOUND ART: art created from undisguised, but often modified, items or products that are not normally considered materials from which art is made, often because they already have a non-art function.







Faith Academy Illness Policy

4.02-8 – FEVER

Students with a temperature of 100 degrees or above will not be allowed to remain in class. A child may return to class when he or she has been without a fever for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.

4.02-19 – VOMITING AND DIARRHEA

Any child who vomits or has diarrhea will be sent home and should remain home until they have not vomited or had diarrhea for a full 24 hours without the aid of medications. If a child vomits or has diarrhea prior to the start of school, we ask that they remain at home and follow the 24 hour policy.






