Faith Academy Volunteers

From its founding, Faith Academy Bellville has relied on the generosity of family and community volunteers to achieve our goals and offer the events and programs we proudly provide our students.

Volunteers Make It All Possible

Parents, families and community members are the glue that make the many events we host possible, from the educational and entertaining field trips to our Night of Knights Gala, the Book Fair and Art Festival, our year-round athletic events and much more. In fact, they're much more than helpers; volunteers are partners in our students' education.

Events Director Suzi Cano and Events Assistant Krista Goebel not only depend on the help volunteers provide but also look forward to the time together to get to know one another.

"I think one of the most precious things about working with the volunteers is the relationships that are built and the strength that comes from the partnership with the parents. This trickles down to the classrooms and the kids, because we all work together and benefit from it. It's how beautiful friendships are built," Suzi said.

There's a Spot for Everyone

In an effort to communicate volunteer opportunities early and also gauge the range of interests and gifts of our parents and volunteers, Suzi and Krista host a Volunteer Informational Meeting in September each year. The options range from event planning, decorating, and clean up to computer entry, pizza pickup, Library and Survive and Thrive support and more. There truly are spots for everyone depending on their schedule and interests.

Several events throughout the year are highly dependent on day-of volunteer support, including fall and spring photos, Western Day, and the Art Festival.

Making the Art Festival Shine

The Spring Art Festival reaches beyond Faith Academy and welcomes schools from across the state to participate. Volunteers ensure the day runs smoothly from start to finish - from displaying student artwork the night before to checking labels, providing hospitality for the judges and computing the scores and awarding the ribbons.

"Every year, we make an impression on the visiting schools and guests. I receive complimentary emails afterwards and even the day of, people come up to us and express their appreciation for the event, from the hospitality to the art layout and the ceremony," Suzi said. "All of the dedicated volunteers working together make the Art Festival run like a well-oiled machine."

All Knights on Hand for NOK

Looking ahead, our Night of Knights Gala fundraiser on Valentine's Day depends on at least 100 volunteers to ensure its success. Fundraising Director Lori McDaniel says volunteers like the talented Shawna Yarbrough begin planning the theme and decorations months in advance. During the week of the event, volunteers help set up tables, chairs, tablecloths, and auction items, and are on hand at Night of Knights to handle event details. Many parents and community members volunteer year after year, which also helps ensure the annual event runs smoothly.

Beyond the Big Events

The dedicated FAB Hospitality Team takes the event vision and runs with the preparation. Because they already know where event furnishings and decor are stored, the Hospitality Team does a swift and beautiful job of setting up events and cleaning up. This year's team of Mrs. Christi Wilson and Mrs. Rebecca Stark has been invaluable!

Room parents also play a vital role throughout the year, not only organizing seasonal parties but also supporting teachers by communicating important information to parents. Our dedicated Room Parent Coordinator, Whitney Dorton, generously gives her time and energy, beginning before the school year begins to recruit room parent volunteers across our Early Education Center (EEC), Elementary, Junior High, and High School, and collaborating with them on their specific events throughout the year.

The Athletics program relies on volunteer parents of athletes year-round to support concessions, ticket sales, team meals and team snacks as well as fundraising, including the annual Volleyball Pink Out auction, with proceeds donated to a local cancer patient.

Outside of events and parties, there are random tasks that volunteers open-heartedly offer to help with when they're on campus, waiting for students at team practices or other activities.

It's All About Heart

"Again, we could not do what we do on the level we do it without our volunteers," Suzi said. "When they come to FAB to volunteer, they are communicating that they love this school. They are saying, 'I love that my kids go to school here, and I want to serve.' I see the heart of our people, our volunteers, when they choose to be a part of what we're doing by serving."

Flu Season is Here



Dear Parents,

Cold and flu season is upon us. Faith Academy kindly asks that you keep your student home if he or she is not feeling well or is exhibiting any flu-like symptoms including, but not limited to fever (temp 100+), cough, sore throat, body aches, headache, chills, fatigue, vomiting, and diarrhea.

Your cooperation helps ensure the health and safety of all our students and staff.



Tips for Students to Stay Well



Frequent Hand Washing



Stay home when you are sick



Fortify your immune system- fluids, rest, healthy diet, exercise



Avoid sharing personal items to prevent the spread of infection. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.

Faith Academy Illness Policy

4.02-8 – FEVER

Students with a temperature of 100 degrees or above will not be allowed to remain in class. A child may return to class when he or she has been without a fever for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.

4.02-19 – VOMITING AND DIARRHEA

Any child who vomits or has diarrhea will be sent home and should remain home until they have not vomited or had diarrhea for a full 24 hours without the aid of medications. If a child vomits or has diarrhea prior to the start of school, we ask that they remain at home and follow the 24 hour policy.



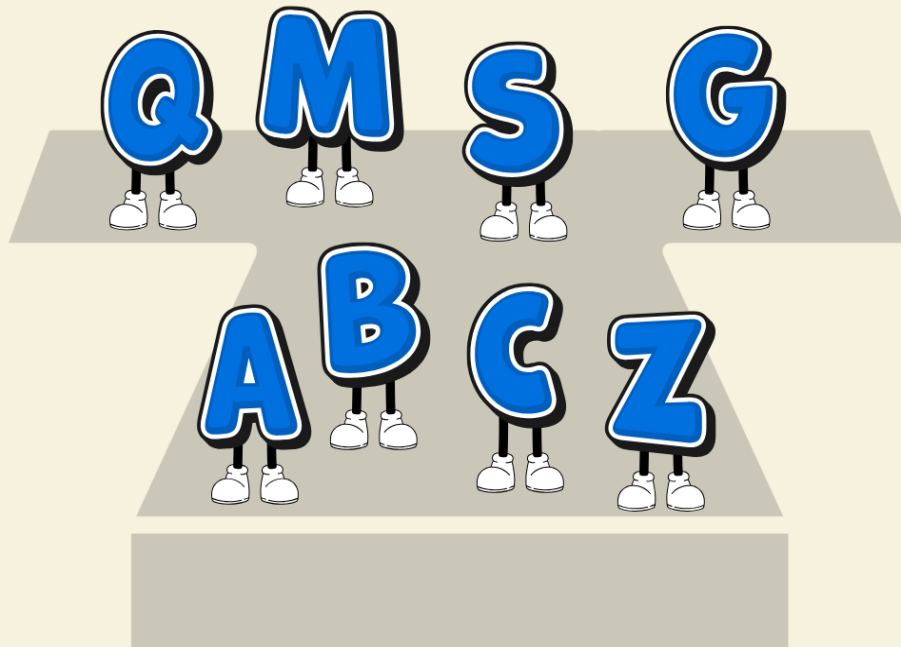
