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# The Knightly News

The annual Night of Knights raffle for a Kubota utility vehicle or zero-turn mower is one of the most anticipated parts of our annual fundraiser. Students begin selling tickets in the heat of August, culminating in a live drawing at the February gala.

Faith Academy Bellville families know when they receive that neon envelope at the beginning of the school year, it's time to sell Kubota raffle tickets! Families, friends, neighbors, and community members, near and far, rally behind our students by purchasing tickets. Many students set up at Bellville Market Days or go door-to-door in their neighborhoods, and some even sell to relatives across the country. Local businesses like the Bellville Meat Market, also jump in to help, making this one of our biggest and most meaningful fundraisers of the year.

The drawing is always held at the end of Night of Knights, and even though you don't have to be present to win, many guests wait around to see who this year's winner will be. The raffle winner can choose one of two prizes: either a Kubota utility vehicle or a Kubota zero-turn lawn mower, while a second winner is drawn for a \$500 prize.

This year, as the raffle barrel turned, the winning ticket was drawn, and the winner's name was called, everyone sat with bated breath, wondering if this would be their year. The winner's name, Monica Krpec, was called, and all looked around to see if she was in the room. When it was clear she wasn't present, our emcee and Junior High math teacher, Mrs. Stacy Woodley, asked the audience if we should call her right then. Of course, everyone whooped and hollered, "Yes!" When Mrs. Krpec answered the phone, her surprise was unmistakable. A Fulshear resident, she had purchased her ticket from a student selling in the neighborhood. It was a joy for everyone to witness her genuine reaction in that winning moment!

The excitement did not end there; the winner of the second drawing for \$500 was FAB Elementary math teacher and Knight Lights pep squad coach Mrs. Jena Hooper. Everyone was thrilled that one of our teachers received this prize.

As students sell raffle tickets throughout the school year leading up to Night of Knights, incentive prizes are awarded to the top seller in each school: Early Education Center (EEC), Elementary, Junior High, and High School. At Night of Knights, the final top-selling winners are announced, including the class that sold the most tickets. This year, the 2nd-grade class was the top seller and earned a coveted trip to the Byler Ranch in Bandera, Texas. They will spend a weekend in May swimming, hiking, searching for arrowheads and other treasures, and making memories to enjoy for years to come.

We also honor the efforts of the individuals who sold the most tickets. Our top sellers this year were: Conway Krolczyk from the EEC and second-grader William Sodolak for K-12. We are so proud of their efforts and their support for FAB.

At Night of Knights, we also raffle off 25% off tuition for the next school year and host a 50/50 drawing where the winner takes home half of that raffle's proceeds. The Feiertag family won the tuition discount, and Mrs. Pat Allee won the 50/50 pot. Thank you to all who purchased these tickets as well!



# FAB ART FESTIVAL

## Categories

**CALLIGRAPHY:** abstract patterns/designs, architectural/commercial designs, hand lettering

**DIGITAL ART:** artwork produced entirely in electronic form - original creation or digitally enhanced student-generated work, graphic design (text with images), 3-D printing

**DRAWING - BLACK & WHITE:** media - chalk, charcoal, ink, pencil, pigma/technical pen, scratchboard

**DRAWING - COLOR:** media - colored pencil, colored ink, crayon, felt markers, pastels (students may enter pastels in the painting category at their discretion)

**FABRIC ART:** cloth mosaic/collage, embroidery, fabric painting, quilting

**FIBER ART:** knitting, crochet, weaving, felting, braiding, macrame, lace making, rug/latch hook, stitchery, string art, fiber sculpture

**MISCELLANEOUS ART:** basketry, jewelry, leather, metal, recycled art, found art, wood, alternative photographic processes (cyanotype, etc.)

**MIXED MEDIA:** a combination of two or more categories, or artwork can be entered in its dominant category

**PAINTING:** media - acrylics, airbrush, encaustics, finger paints, oil, tempera, watercolor

**PAPER ART:** cast paper, diorama, origami, paper mosaic/collage, paper projects, altered art, art journaling

**PHOTOGRAPHY - FILM:** Images created with a film camera and printed on silver gelatin paper, color or black and white. It may be commercially processed or student processed.

**PHOTOGRAPHY - DIGITAL:** black and white or color (Photographs that include any person(s) must be accompanied by a completed photo release form for each person in the photograph.)

**POTTERY:** (functional pieces from fired clay) wheel-thrown or handmade

**PRINTMAKING:** relief, intaglio, rubbings, silk screen, sponge, stamping, stenciling

**RELIEF SCULPTURE** (*including subtractive process*): works presented in a relief extending over 1/4 inch above the surface or base

**SCULPTURE - 3 DIMENSIONAL, SHAPED BY THE STUDENT:** media - ceramic with handmade mold, clay, metal, paper mache, plaster, soap, stone, wood

**LEGO ART:** media - authentic Lego pieces that cannot be a kit, or already designed scene by Lego. No part of the design resembles any existing LEGO set or official scene. The style is expressive, imaginative, and sculptural—an artwork born entirely from the artist's creative vision.

**FOUND ART:** art created from undisguised, but often modified, items or products that are not normally considered materials from which art is made, often because they already have a non-art function.

## 6th Grade Field Trip

Our 6th graders had an incredible time on their recent field trip to the Houston Museum of Natural Science! The day was packed with new adventures and hands-on learning as students moved through the exhibits. A favorite for many was the Cockrell Butterfly Center, where students walked among hundreds of beautiful butterflies including some newly hatched in the center. This was also where they were able to get up close with live hissing cockroaches which was an experience that received very mixed emotions among the students! They also explored the fascinating "Death by Natural Causes" exhibit, which had all of the students talking long after leaving the museum. In the Matter & Motion exhibit, they interacted with hands-on displays that brought physics concepts to life. Overall, the trip was a wonderful opportunity for students to connect with real-world science in a fun and memorable way.


