As we wrap up the 2025-26 school year at Faith Academy Bellville (FAB), we're feeling a bit nostalgic, looking back at where we started and where we are now. Praise to God for a year of growth and grace!

A Growing FAB Family

We began the school year with 80 new students and 13 talented new teachers and staff - all of whom quickly became part of the FAB Knight family. Enrollment for the upcoming school year is underway, with interest in FAB growing yet again. Some grades are already at capacity, and we're actively hiring more talented teachers to serve as many students as possible.

Growth at FAB goes far beyond report cards. We're committed to developing the whole child, academically, physically, and spiritually, and character is at the center of that work. This year, our elementary students explored what it means to live out kindness, respect for authority, responsibility, and perseverance through lessons led by Elementary Director Mrs. Jennifer McCutcheon, helping our students grow into the people God intended them to be.

Loving Our Neighbors

Service to others is a core value at FAB, and our students lived it out all year long. During Breast Cancer Awareness Month, our volleyball teams hosted the Pink Out silent auction, with proceeds going to a community member undergoing cancer treatment. The whole student body packed 96 Operation Christmas Child boxes, while our Elementary Survive & Thrive students brought love and Christmas cheer to all 48 residents of Colonial Living. And as we counted our own blessings at Thanksgiving, FAB FFA donated 7 boxes of non-perishable food to Katy Christian Ministries Food Pantry.

Faith Academy is home to the FALCON Center, our neurodevelopment program. This year, the FALCON Center built on our existing Omega community class, which is geared towards adult brain health, and offered the Alpha class, which educates parents on how movement affects their baby's or young child's brain development. Both classes offer extensive education free of charge to anyone interested in attending. The Great FALCON Crawl Off kicked off in January, using the repetitive cross-body movements to improve our students' vision, coordination, and focus.

A Year Worth Celebrating

The FAB students and staff love a celebration, and we've had many this year! Our annual Night of Knights Gala welcomed more than 350 guests to the "Diamonds and Bows" themed event. Attendees enjoyed the Aggie Wranglers performance, a steak dinner, and the thrill of calling the Kubota Raffle Winner on the phone with the good news live during the event. The 2nd-grade class won the trip to the Byler Ranch in Bandera, Texas, for selling the most raffle tickets, and the live and silent auctions raised money for the school.

Our Knight athletes gave their all this year! Football and volleyball each earned regional finalist honors, with Kate Lanham named Honorable Mention All-State in volleyball. Girls' basketball reached the area finals behind All-State honoree Jayleen Jackson. Ethan Stegent (2nd place) and Daniela Skardenni (6th place) represented FAB at the cross country state meet, the golf team placed 10th at state, baseball was a bi-district finalist, and the boys' track team finished 3rd at regionals. This weekend, our track state qualifiers compete in Waco: Kate Lanham, Peyton Eckermann, Eve Hyslop, Ethan Stegent, Jackson Dunn, Brody August, Josh Stark, and Kelton Galle. Shields Up!

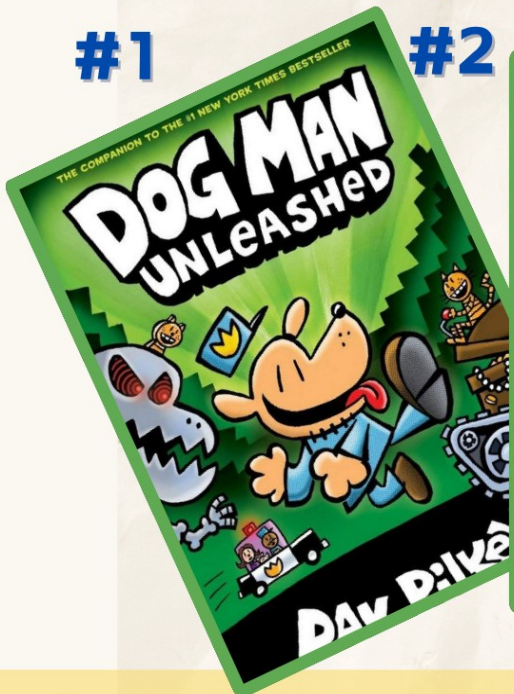




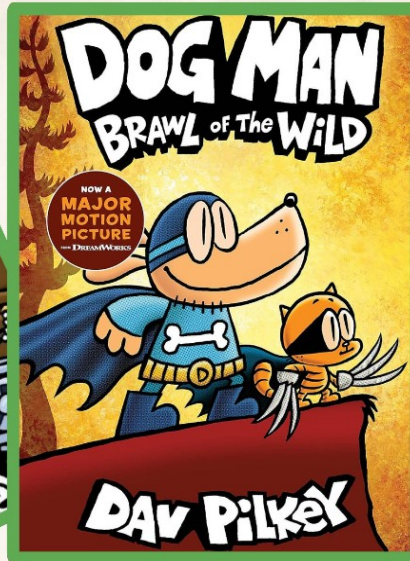

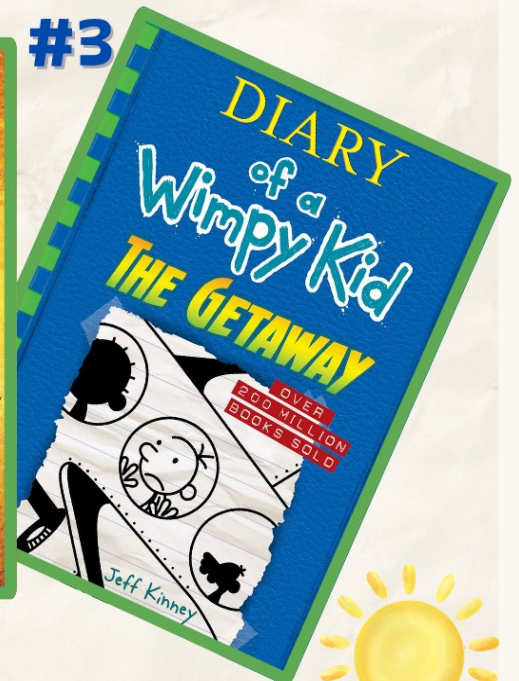
