The month of May is jam-packed with end-of-year events and celebrations! At Faith Academy Bellville (FAB), we love closing out the year by honoring the growth, effort, and gifts of our outstanding students, teachers, and staff.

## **Honoring the Hearts In the Classrooms**

We kick off May with Teacher and Staff Appreciation Week. This year's theme centers around how teachers and staff are as impactful as a book. Each day has a fun, book-centered focus, from the "Where the Wild Things Are" trail mix assortment to the "If you give FAB staff a Cookie, then they'll want a coffee" bar. Each day is also centered on a corresponding scripture, such as "Let anyone who is thirsty, come to me and drink." John 7:37. We are grateful for the dedication of our teachers and staff who are led by Christ each day to teach and support our students.

The last pep rally of the year is always a favorite, and this week's Aloha Spirit celebration is no exception. We're honoring both our dedicated teachers and staff and the hard work and success of our junior high and high school track teams. Students, teachers, and staff will arrive in colorful floral prints, leis, and cool shades, bringing their Knight Spirit to life in true island fashion.

## **Launching Our Seniors into the Next Chapter**

Our graduating seniors are front and center as we prepare to launch them into the next chapter of their lives. Because our classes are limited, we get to know our students well over the years they spend at FAB, and saying "see you later" is never easy.

Early in May, we host the Senior Send-Off, where the entire school, family, friends, and community pray over our seniors in a moving chapel service. We are all praying that they listen to God's call for their lives and where He is taking them next.

After they practice for graduation, while still decked out in cap and gown, seniors surprise the elementary students with a walk-through of Building 7. For the elementary kids, it's a glimpse of where they're headed. For the seniors, it's a look back at how far they've come.

## **Recognizing Growth at Every Level**

In separate award celebrations, we share in the excitement of all that our elementary, junior high, and high school students have accomplished. The high school ceremony is a more formal affair titled "Academy Awards." With a red carpet and semi-formal attire, students are recognized for top academic achievement and accomplishments in Spring athletic events. Time is taken to honor each top student with a special introductory speech from teachers and coaches. These awards go beyond grades, recognizing the growth each student has achieved throughout the year.

## **A Blessing That Became a Tradition**

High school graduation will be held on Sunday, May 17, 2026. Not only do our graduates proudly walk across the stage, but they also receive a special "Class Blessing" from our Chaplain, Mrs. Amy Catlett.

The Class of 2008 asked Mrs. Catlett to serve as their commencement speaker, and, as part of her address, she wrote a personal blessing for each student rooted in the relationships she had built in the classroom and, in recent years, has tied the blessing to scripture that the seniors chose for their graduation program. What started as a one-off request has now become a cherished 18-year tradition.

The last day of school is always a celebration to remember. Elementary students close out the year with games and fun activities during Field Day, while high school students compete in volleyball, tug-of-war, and a cook-off, all vying for the coveted Blue Bowl Trophy.
