#### A Loving Foundation: How Faith Academy's EEC Nurtures Children and Families

When you step into the Early Education Center (EEC) at Faith Academy Bellville, the calm is striking, especially considering the youngest students fill the classrooms each day. Ranging from 12 months to 4 years old, these little learners experience the love of Jesus Christ and the foundations of learning each day.

EEC Director Tammy Shuck and a team of 13 teachers, most of whom have also served long tenures at the EEC, provide a structured but loving environment. This secure and nurturing foundation accounts for the peace felt when you walk into the building, and also why a line of tiny children stopped mid-interview to hug "Mrs. Shuck."

"These children are innocent, and I want the parents to know that when they drive off and go to work or go wherever they need to go, that we're going to love their babies well and take care of them," Tammy said.

#### From Substitute to Shepherd

As EEC director, Tammy sees herself as a shepherd to her team and the children themselves. After all, she was first a teacher herself.

What started as a two-week substitute job for Tammy turned into a 31-year tenure at Faith Academy. While Tammy initially taught the students and grades as needed, she eventually found her niche in the Early Education Center. She enjoyed teaching so much that it took her several years to accept the position of EEC director.

"I didn't think I'd ever want to get out of the classroom, and Mrs. Byler was lovely and patient. She'd ask me, and I wasn't ready for several years," Tammy said.

#### **Supporting Families Beyond the Classroom**

Not only are Tammy and her team passionate about caring for the children, but they also seek to support the young families of the EEC. The pressures on families these days are constantly increasing and coming from all directions, including on social media.

"I see Faith Academy as a light in the community. We continue to raise the standard of Jesus Christ, and although we're not perfect, we will not waver from God's word. The world's changing, but we don't have to," she explained with emotion in her voice.

#### **Education Rooted in Faith and Growth**

The EEC curriculum features age-appropriate activities designed to support gross and fine motor development, reading, writing, and number skills, while also helping form their Christian faith.

Each day begins with a devotion that includes singing songs, exploring the Bible, and learning how to pray. Scripture teachings are also integrated into everyday interactions.

"If Susie is pulling Johnny's hair, we can say, 'Remember Ephesians 43:2. What does God say about our hands?" Tammy explained.

Every EEC student also participates in the Faith Alliance Learning Connection Of Neurodevelopment (FALCON) program, which helps students strengthen their brains and bodies to reach their fullest, Godgiven potential through fun, interactive exercises.

#### **Learning Through Imagination**

Throughout the year, the EEC is transformed into another world, literally, to immerse children in a learning experience. In one lesson where they learn about other countries and cultures, students board the Faith Academy bus and, after a few trips around the parking lot, are transported to Mexico. Upon entering the building, they present their passports and enjoy food, clothing and activities from that culture.

The EEC has also become Candyland for the Day, where students play the children's game as life-size players, enjoy throwing snowballs, and decorate gingerbread houses. When learning about God's creation of colors, they celebrated "Dog's Colorful Day" based on the children's book.

#### The Heart of EEC: Teachers and Special Helpers

Tammy says none of this would be possible without the dedicated teachers and the support staff.

"These kids love their teachers. Their teachers are wonderful and warm, and (the students) trust them. Their relationship is so important," she said.

Helping make each day possible are two exceptional support staff members. Like many of the dedicated women in the EEC, receptionist Cathy Nettles has been part of Faith Academy for more than nine years, serving in several roles before joining the EEC team in 2016.

"The Faith Academy EEC is uniquely tailored to what young kids need. I wish everyone could see how Mrs. Shuck and the teachers connect with these little ones whose needs can be very different," Cathy said. "I love watching their growth every year."

"Cathy is my right hand. She has a cheerful attitude and a servant's heart, and she keeps us going," Tammy said.

Another beloved member of the EEC is 'Momo,' as she's affectionately called. At 92 years old, her wisdom and kindness shine through in everything she does, from sharing encouragement to creating the beautiful decorations and teaching materials that make lessons engaging and meaningful. "I love serving the children and teachers in the EEC," Momo said.

Tammy said, "Momo works circles around everybody. She ensures that the teachers have all the necessary materials, allowing them to focus on the children and their teaching. She's the sweetest."

#### **Serving the Growing Community**

The present-day EEC building, which opened in 2016, was designed with the children's growth and learning in mind. Though it was larger than immediately needed, it quickly became clear that the extra space would be essential; enrollment grew rapidly, and all 12 classes filled right away. This year, to accommodate even more little learners, the nursery class moved to Building One next door.

For Tammy, the building is more than just classrooms and hallways. "I get emotional when I think about this building, and it's not because it's new or beautiful," she said. "It represents our commitment to the community, to teach about Jesus and raise children to be kingdom-minded."

Today, the EEC continues to welcome new students while also seeing Faith Academy alums return, bringing their own children into the same loving, structured, and faith-filled environment. Tammy and her team are proud that another generation of students will begin their educational journey with the strong, nurturing foundation that has become the hallmark of the EEC.
