Building Community, One Event at a Time Sept. 10, 2025

At Faith Academy Bellville, events aren't simply milestones to celebrate. They are central to creating and strengthening the bonds among students, teachers, staff, volunteers, parents, and the larger community.

Overseeing more than 70 events each school year, from class field trips and teacher and staff appreciation celebrations to the homecoming court, statewide art festival, and senior graduation, Director of Events Suzi Cano and Events Assistant Krista Goebel ensure every detail brings the Faith Academy community together.

Both Suzi and Krista began their careers as elementary school receptionists at Faith Academy, a role they say prepared them to serve the school community as part of the Events Team.

"During my time as the elementary receptionist, I witnessed firsthand the dedication our teachers show to students and the immense effort they give each day," Suzi explained. "That unique role sparked the passion I have now for celebrating and supporting our teachers and staff through the events Krista and I help plan."

"I also fell in love with the community here, and the teachers and the staff. I think it helped us in our department to see how hard teachers work every day in the classroom, and it helps us to love them better," Krista said.

Supporting and Celebrating Teachers and Staff

This experience inspires Suzi and Krista to continuously seek out thoughtful ways to support and celebrate Faith Academy's teachers and staff, from surprising everyone with their favorite Sonic drink on the first day of school to hosting the much-anticipated Christmas party.

Championing teachers also means handling the behind-the-scenes details—setting up tables, adding table-cloths, arranging chairs, and more for events like the Science Fair, Wax Museum, and Book Fair. By taking on these tasks, Suzi and Krista lighten the teachers' load, creating space for students and teachers to show-case their learning to parents and families.

Showcasing Student Gifts and Growth

Suzi and Krista see events not only as a way to applaud students for their hard work in the classroom, but also as opportunities for growth. Working alongside our fantastic music teachers, the events team creates opportunities for students to showcase their talents, whether speaking, singing, or playing instruments, before an audience at events such as Grandparents' Day Chapel, the signature Christmas musical productions presented by both the Early Childhood Center (EEC) and Elementary students, the statewide art festival, or other occasions.

"Faith Academy is rich in providing a platform for students to express their God-given gifts in a tangible way through the events," said Suzi.

Both Suzi and Krista have their own favorite traditions that reflect what makes Faith Academy so special.

"Senior graduation is my favorite event," Suzi shared. "It's the culmination of everything our teachers have poured into the students over the years." Krista smiled as she added, "As a photographer, I especially love the annual Art Festival. It's amazing to see student artists from all over Texas bring their work to Faith Academy each spring."

Love in Every Detail

Even though the student body and staff have doubled in size over the past eight years since Suzi started working at Faith Academy, the Events Team aims to maintain the level of excellence that Faith Academy events have become known for. This involves keeping a jam-packed calendar, often weeks of planning, and attention to details like ensuring every student can be seen and heard.

As they both emphasize, even a flawlessly executed event falls short if it comes at the cost of strife or mistreatment. The true goal isn't just to pull off an event and move on; it's to strengthen and nurture relationships throughout the process.

To think of others above yourself and create a caring and loving environment is fundamental to Faith Academy's culture. "It is all for Him," Suzi explained.

A Cherished Tradition: Grandparents' Day Chapel

On Monday, September 8, 2025, we welcomed around 800 students and guests to Grandparents' Chapel, where the students performed for these cherished family members to show their love and appreciation. Grandparents also had the opportunity to see classrooms and meet teachers. It's one of the most treasured traditions of the year.

There's no rest for the weary or the Faith Academy Events team. This year, Homecoming falls the same week as Grandparents' Chapel. While the schedule can be overwhelming, Suzi and Krista truly see each event as an opportunity to show love and bring people together
