The annual Grandparents' Day event is a cherished tradition at Faith Academy of Bellville (FAB). On Friday, September 11, 2026, more than 500 guests celebrated with us across our campus - the Early Education Center, Elementary School, Junior High, and High School. In each space, children excitedly grabbed a grandparent's hand to take them to their classroom, leaned into them during worship songs, and simply enjoyed having their grandparents at school.

In years past, all grandparents and students gathered for a special Monday chapel in the Beth Keaton Gymnasium, but this year each building held a special event to accommodate the blessing of our growing student body.

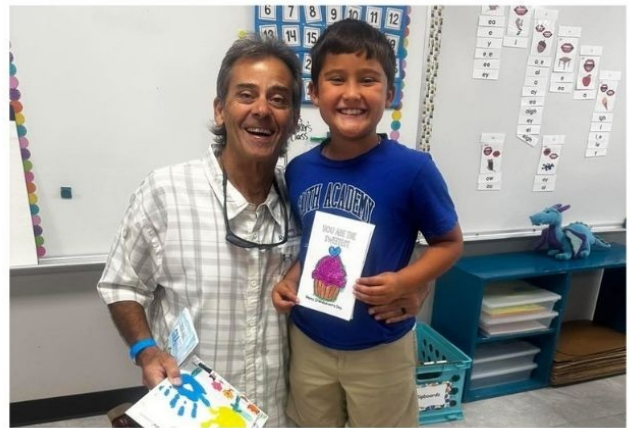
Across FAB, students buzzed with the same question all morning: when would their grandparents arrive?

The two groups then swapped: the younger students sang and performed for their guests, while the older students led their grandparents on classroom tours and teacher introductions.

MRS. CATLETT'S GIFT OF TIME

After another worship song, Mrs. Amy Catlett, the FAB Chaplain and grandmother herself, shared a devotional emphasizing the unique role grandparents play in their grandchildren's lives. Through a personal story about eating ice cream in bed with three of her grandchildren, something she did not do with her own children because routines needed to be kept, Mrs. Catlett conveyed that grandparents can offer a special gift to their grandchildren - time.

A FAMILY TREE OF BLESSINGS

Though each building's celebration was a bit different, each centered on the same theme—Rooted in Faith and Growing in Christ—using the family tree as the visual representation. Grandparents were invited to write a special message on a paper leaf and place it on the tree in their grandchild's school building. In the EEC, the line was long as tiny hands grasped their grandparent's hand to place the leaf in the exact right spot. The Elementary students will see their tree filled with hopes, prayers, and special messages each day as they enter for the first time, at lunchtime, and as they prepare to head home. Junior High and High School students will also pass by their tree multiple times a day as they change classes, blessing

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

About Donating Blood

A little preparation goes a long way toward a great donation experience.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Check In – Show your I.D. and confirm your information.

Quick Health Screening – Answer private health questions and receive a mini health check (temperature, hemoglobin level, and blood pressure).

Get Comfortable – Staff will prep your arm and help you get settled.

Donate – Donate whole blood, which takes about 10 minutes, or choose to do a specialized donation to help meet a patient's specific needs.

Recover – Have a drink and snack, then rest in the post-donation area for 15 minutes after donating.

Follow Up – Log in to your account 24 hours after your donation to leave feedback, check on health results and rewards, and schedule your next appointment.

Ask your provider about taking 18–38 mg of iron daily before donating.



Get a good night's sleep.



Eat a hearty meal.



Drink water before your appointment.



Complete your health history questions in advance using the CFL Express Pass.

Hydrate and enjoy a salty snack.



Avoid heavy lifting or strenuous activity for 24 hours.
