### Faith Academy Bellville Celebrates Team Spirit and Community with Homecoming Week!

The excitement of Homecoming Week began with a favorite tradition: Grandparents Day Chapel, where 800 guests, students, teachers, and staff gathered to celebrate faith, family, and community. Our talented music teachers, Mr. and Mrs. Arnold, began preparing for this treasured performance as soon as the new school year started, allowing our students to showcase their talents and love for their families.

Homecoming officially got underway with the HOCO Kick-Off Family Fun Night and Bonfire. We relished in the beautiful taste of fall weather while families, students, teachers, staff, and community enjoyed tasty bites from food trucks, played beanbag toss, and bounced through inflatable fun.

The Knight Lights elementary pep squad and junior high cheerleaders brought spirit and excitement with lively performances that set the tone for the week's games. Adding to the laughter, students raised funds by smashing whipped cream pies into the faces of their teachers and coaches, followed by the highly anticipated lighting of the bonfire.

Throughout the week, students enjoyed dress-up days. Instead of uniforms, they sported camouflage, team spirit shirts, and matching class dress-up. The week culminated in the Faith Academy blue-out pep rally on Friday, where our Homecoming King, Joshua Stark, was crowned in front of the entire school and our guests.

During halftime at Friday night's varsity football game, we recognized this year's Homecoming Court and crowned Daniela Skardenni Homecoming Queen. After the game, high school students capped off the night by dancing together at the Homecoming Dance.

### Athletes Brought the Spirit of Homecoming

The Lady Knights varsity volleyball team opened district play with an impressive 3–0 sweep of Memorial Lutheran, starting the season 1–0. They will travel on Tuesday to face Cypress Covenant and return home on Thursday to take on Founders. Both varsity matches are scheduled for 6 p.m.

In junior high action, the Lady Knights Blue team defeated Memorial Lutheran in straight sets, 2–0, in their season opener. They will also play at Cypress Covenant on Tuesday and host Founders on Thursday, with both matches beginning at 5 p.m. The JH White team will see its first action on Thursday against Founders at 4 p.m. Both junior high squads are set to compete in the Lady Knight Junior High Volleyball Tournament on Saturday.

The Knights' cross country team turned in strong performances at the Moulton Invitational in Moulton, Texas. Ethan Stegent claimed first place in the varsity boys division, while Daniela Skardenni finished 10th in the varsity girls race. In the junior high girls division, Eva Broadbent and Shelby Poulter ran outstanding races. Quinton Moore competed well in the JV boys division, and Everett Miglicco represented strongly in the junior high boys race. Official results for the JV boys and both junior high divisions were not available at press time.

The Knights varsity football team faced a tough challenge Friday night, falling to the Ft. Bend Chargers, 46–0. The team will look to regroup before their next contest on October 3, when they travel to Waco to face Waco Valor. Kickoff is set for 7 p.m.

The junior high football team also came up short against Ft. Bend, dropping their game 30–0. They will return to action on October 3 at Waco Valor, with kickoff scheduled for 5 p.m.

### One last nod to Summer!

Faith Academy Elementary students had the opportunity to participate in a summer "Read and Grow with God" challenge during their break from school this year. Students not only maintained their reading habits throughout the summer by being encouraged to read in fun places - by the water, in a fort, or while wearing pajamas - but they were also challenged to memorize a Bible verse, have a completely screen-free day, and perform a kind act for a friend. As a reward for completing the challenge, students received a free dress pass and a popsicle party at lunchtime. It was a great day at Faith Academy, and we love watching our students grow as readers and leaders!
