MISSION / FOUNDATIONS

MISSION

Faith Academy is to be a place of encouragement and excellence in academic and character training where The Light of the World, Jesus Christ, lives in and enlightens those who teach and learn.

PHILOSOPHY

The educational philosophy of Faith Academy is based on a God-centered view of truth and man as presented in the Bible. The purpose of the school is to raise up Jesus Christ as the standard of excellence in education and the student's identity in Christ as the foundation of his spiritual, mental, physical and social development. The authority for such an education comes both from God's command and from the fact that parents are responsible for the total education and training of their children. At the parent's request, Faith Academy becomes a partner in giving this education.

HISTORY

Faith Academy began as an idea from a committee in 1993. Classes began for the first time in the fall of 1994 with nine students in kindergarten through fifth grade. A grade was added each year, and in May 2003, Faith Academy held its first senior graduation.

AFFILIATIONS

Faith Academy is an evangelical interdenominational school. It is not aligned with or supported by a particular church or denomination. It is a member of Association of Christian Schools International and is fully accredited with the Texas Alliance of Accredited Private Schools.

CURRICULUM / ACTIVITIES

CURRICULUM

Faith Academy believes that a quality education is the result of teachers that are Christian in practice and philosophy, and a curriculum that integrates God's truth into all courses and adequately prepares the student for future educational endeavors.

It is Faith Academy's desire to have a curriculum that challenges the student, stimulates curiosity, promotes creativity, teaches the discipline of study habits, develops critical thinking, and encourages individual responsibility.

CAMPUS OFFERINGS

Faith Academy is housed on more than 30 acres along Hwy. 36, south of Bellville. The campus features five buildings, including an early childhood building, elementary building, junior high building, high school building, ag and weight room building, as well as a gym, playground and athletic fields.

The faculty and staff at Faith Academy work hard to create a loving, caring, and safe environment where the student is nurtured in personal growth, challenged academically, and directed to high standards.

Students are required to respond with "Ma'am" and "Sir" at all times. A dress code with a variety of clothing choices is also enforced. Corporate chapel services are held weekly, with daily Bible teaching in each classroom.

In addition to traditional curriculum, secondary students are offered a variety of extracurricular courses, which may include art, , computer, music, journalism, yearbook publication, home economics, theater arts, and agriculture science.

Athletics are also available as student enrollment allows. Traditionally, fall sports include cross country, football and volleyball. Winter and spring sports may include basketball, baseball, softball, track and field. Cheerleading is also offered.

The administration stresses that the head of each home is chiefly responsible before God for the discipline of each child. On campus, students are subject to the principles of "Discipline With Love", a policy with more than 40 years of success. Parents are required to attend a parent class and to observe their child in the classroom for at least one hour each semester.

Sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ and raising Him up as the standard is the mission at Faith Academy.

3. After ALL of the above mentioned paperwork is received and reviewed, you will be contacted in regard to scheduling an **entrance screening**. Parents, please plan on attending with your child for the duration of the screening which will take approximately 1-2 hours. This is required for students entering **Kindergarten – Grade 12**. The entrance screening requires the payment of a \$100 fee and is due on the date of the screening.
4. On a separate day we will schedule an **academic screening** followed immediately by a **family interview to review screening results**.
5. The administration will contact parents to and to discuss final enrollment or denial of enrollment.
6. **Orientation and final enrollment** for any age Faith Academy student will not be complete until the following information is received for each child:
 - Signed Financial Contract
 - Payment of registration fee of \$175 per student or \$350 per family
