Skills

Perform custodial duties such as cleaning, sweeping, mopping, vacuuming, dusting, polishing and trash removal of classrooms, offices, cafeterias, computer labs, break rooms, bathrooms, locker rooms, hallways, entryways, gymnasiums, weight rooms and other areas of a facility excluding exterior grounds. Respond to requests, last minute needs, unscheduled events, changes, etc. regarding building use. Assist Operations Manager with training, evaluation and daily work load of night custodians. Monitor and inspect building facilities for safety and cleanliness. Maintain and make minor repairs to the facility and troubleshoot and report areas requiring maintenance to the supervisor. Notify the building supervisor of hazardous or harmful situations. Secure facility by locking doors, windows, and setting alarms. Monitor building security throughout the shift. Report supply and equipment needs to Operations Manager. Perform daily preventative maintenance of site custodial equipment. Ensure proper use, identification, mixture and application of chemicals. Comply with energy conservation procedures. Attend work and arrive in a timely manner. Perform special cleaning during summer and break times.
