August 15-19

Genesis 1:1

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

August 22-26

John 3:16-17

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.

August 29- September 2

Romans 10:9

If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

September 5-9

Galatians 2:20

I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

Romans 6:6

Romans 8:1

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

John 1:12

But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name.

1 Peter 1:22b

Love one another fervently with a pure heart.

I have been made complete in Christ

Colossians 2:9-10a

For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily; and you are complete in Him..

John 15:15a

No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends..

Psalm 107:1

Oh give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! His mercy endures forever.

1 Corinthians 15:57

But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
